



Bharatanatyam is dressed in a colorful <u>sari</u>, adorned with jewelry who presents a dance synchronized with Indian

classical music. Their hand and facial gestures are coded sign language that recite a legend, spiritual ideas or a religious prayer derived from Hindu Vedic scriptures, the Mahabharata, the Ramayana, the Puranas and historic drama



texts. The dancer deploys turns or specific body movements to mark punctuations in the story or the entry of a different character in the play or legend being acted out through dance.



The peacock dance or peafowl dance is a traditional <u>Asian folk</u> dance that describes the beauty and the movement of <u>peacocks</u>. The peacock

dance of the Dai ethnic group has a very long history and is closely tied with their distinguished ethnic culture. Any festival occasion or celebration such as Closing | Opening Festival is accompanied by the peacock dance, to express joy and happiness.

Yakshagana is a traditional folk dance form popular in <u>Coastal Karnataka</u> districts.

A trip to the coastal belt would be incomplete without watching the Yakshagana — an elaborate dance-drama performance unique to Karnataka. It is a rare combination of dance, music, song, scholarly dialogues and colourful costumes. A celestial world unfolds before the audience, as loud singing and drumming form a backdrop to dancers clad in striking costumes. Hence the name Yaksha (celestial) Gana (music).

deficiency anemia signs and symptoms may Include, Extreme fatigue , Weakness , Pale skin , Chest pain , fast heartbeat or shortness of breath , Headache , dizziness or lightheadedness , Cold hands and feet , Inflammation or soreness of your tongue , Brittle nails. Rtn Dr. Hari A Shetty explained the causes , Symptoms and Food to be added to the diet and maintain iron levels .
